

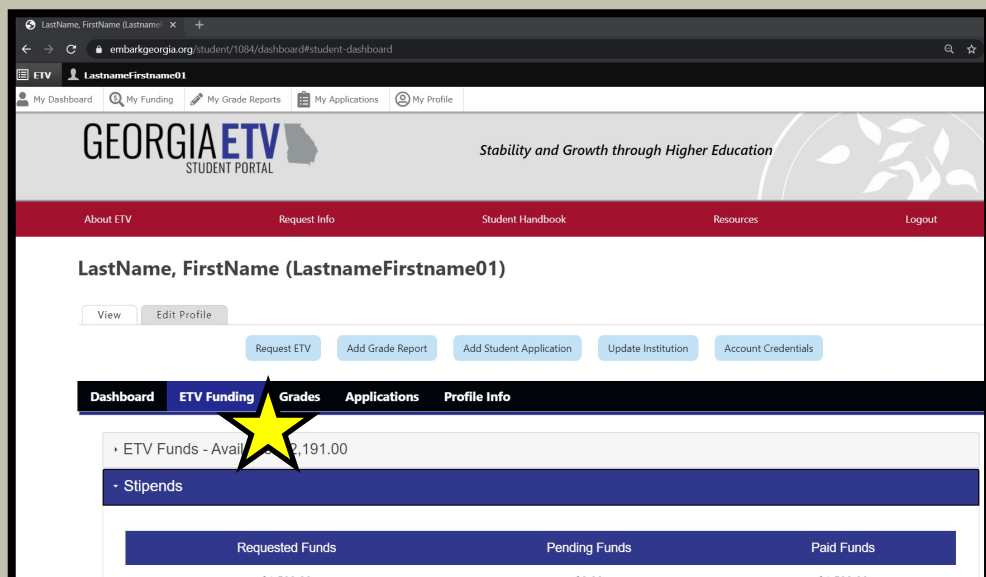
In order for Georgia ETV students to receive a stipend, they first must qualify (see qualifications below) and then must request their stipend through the Georgia ETV site.

In order to qualify for a stipend, students must...

- Be an ETV eligible student
- Be taking a full-time schedule as defined by their office of financial aid (often 12 semester hours)
- Be in compliance with the ETV grade policy
- Submit their request during the current semester (stipends cannot be requested for previous or future semester)

To view current stipend status...

Login to the student portal, navigate to the [ETV Funding](#) link on the black navigation bar and click. Then use the drop down menu for stipends

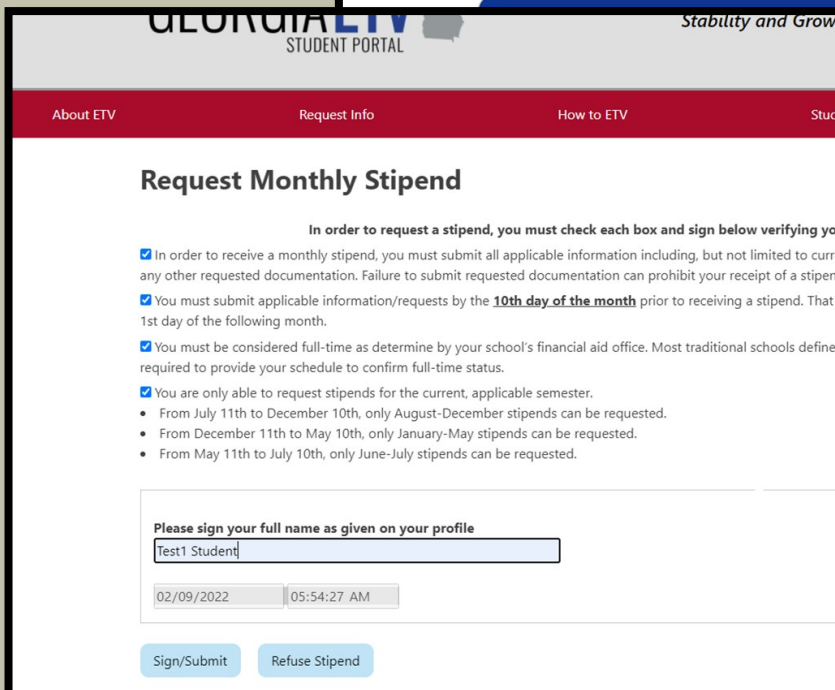
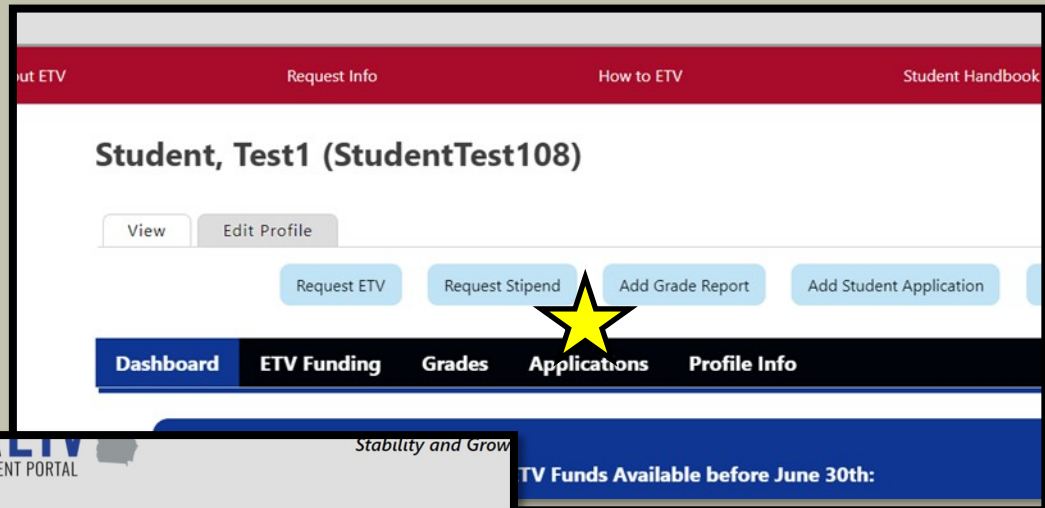


In order to request a student stipend, students must first have...

- An accepted, annual application on their applications link
- An accepted grade report from their most recently attended semester

Students should make sure to upload their current semester schedule and answer questions to determine their eligibility and monthly stipend amount


Students will select all months they will be a full time student this semester and sign off...

Other important notes about stipends:

Stipends are reloaded onto your Dash Prepaid Card on the 1st day of each month. A request for a stipend must be submitted by 10th day of the prior month. For example, ETV must receive the request for an April stipend by March 10th in order for it to be reloaded on April 1st. If the request for a stipend is received after the 10th, it will not be reloaded on the 1st of the next month, but the month after that. For example, if the request is received March 16th, the card will be reloaded on May 1st.

And stipends not received in the current semester cannot be processed.
